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1. Get-Price-Availability & Get-Nonstock-Price API Updates

1.1 Summary

The Get-Price-Availability and Get-Nonstock-Price APIs have been updated within recent weeks to align with the CSR team use cases for the APIs.

Previously the two APIs had very different request parameters for each, where each API would only be called in specific scenarios in VallenIQ.

With recent changes, we consolidated the request parameters for both APIs, allowing for flexibility to support scenarios in which the Get-Price-Availability API can pivot to call the Get-Nonstock-Price API when stocking items are not stocked in the specified warehouse for a quote.

Additionally, we've reduced the number of requests VallenIQ must make to the APIs in order to update line items with appropriate pricing and availability.

1.2 Request Parameters

Both Get-Price-Availability and Get-Nonstock-Price APIs now utilize mostly the same request parameters. The only differences are the addition of the company_number field for the Get-Nonstock-Price API and the addition of the uom field for the Get-Price-Availability API.

1.2.1 New Request Parameters

The following fields below are those that have been added to both APIs.

1.2.1.1 vendor_number

The vendor_number field is required for both API requests. This field is used as an input to determine what the appropriate pricing and/or availability is for your line items.

The vendor_number is populated first by the vendor code that is associated with a line item, and in the absence of vendor code, VallenIQ will then use the manufacturer code. Note that some line items will only have a manufacturer code or a vendor code, and others will have both.

Based on the codes that are available for a line item, VallenIQ will use the logic below to determine which code to use when populating the vendor_code field for both APIs.

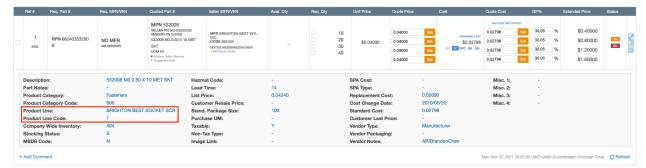
- If manufacturer code and vendor code are available for a line item, use vendor code to populate this field
- If only vendor code is available for a line item, use vendor code to populate this field
- If only manufacturer code is available for a line item, use manufacturer code to populate this field

1.2.1.2 product_line

The product line field is required for both API requests.

VallenIQ will utilize a new file that has been added to the master data titled product_line to look up and populate the appropriate value for this field in both API requests. The vendor code that is associated with the line item and the warehouse code associated with the quote will be used to look up product_line values in the new table.

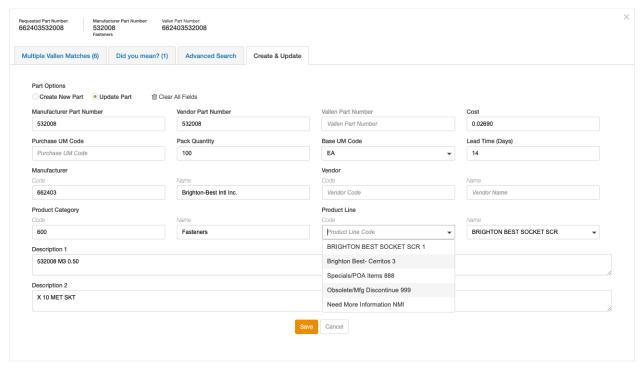
Note that after looking up matching product_line values, the system will also display the matching product line and code in Expand View:

Additionally, the product line code and name will also appear in the Create & Update tab. Users will have the ability to see what Product Line Codes and Names are available for the Vendor + Warehouse combination for the line item.

Note that users will not be able to free form type into these two fields and only valid options will appear in the dropdown.

1.2.1.3 cost1, cost2, cost3, cost4

New cost fields "cost1-4" have been added to both APIs' request parameters. These fields are in addition to the "cost" field that also exists in the request for Get-Price-Availability and Get-Nonstock-Price APIs.

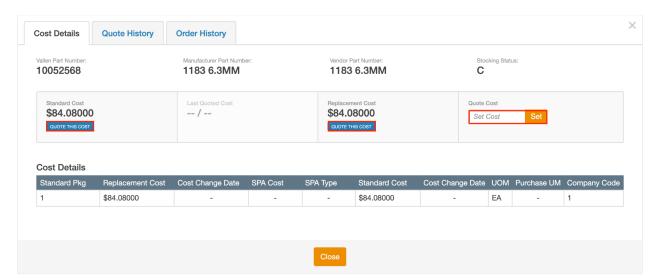
The purpose of the cost field vs. cost1-4 is as follows:

- The cost API request parameter is populated for both Get-Price-Availability and Get-Nonstock-Price APIs in the following scenarios:
 - During "Refresh," which occurs:
 - When line items are uploaded into a quote for the first time
 - When the part number is changed for a line item
 - When Customer Account, Warehouse, or Ship To Suffix fields are changed in the quote header
 - When Cost field is updated using Create & Update
- The cost1-4 API request parameters are only populated for non-stock parts and are only used when calling the Get-Nonstock-Price API. The two use cases for populating these parameters are:
 - When users edit Quote Cost breaks directly in the Quote Cost column for non-stock parts:

Or when cost is changed via the Cost Details modal for non-stock parts:



Updating Quote Costs in Cost Details

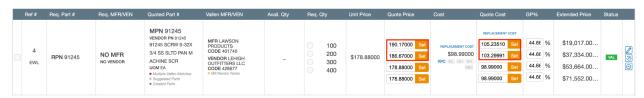
In these two scenarios, only the specific Quote Cost column breaks that were updated will populate cost1-4, and the Get-Nonstock-Price API will only return Quote Prices that correspond with the Quote Cost values that were submitted.

For example, using the non-stock example below:

Quote Cost breaks 1 and 2 were manually changed directly in the Quote Cost column, and the Get-Nonstock-Price API returned prices for only the corresponding Quote Price values, which were then updated accordingly:

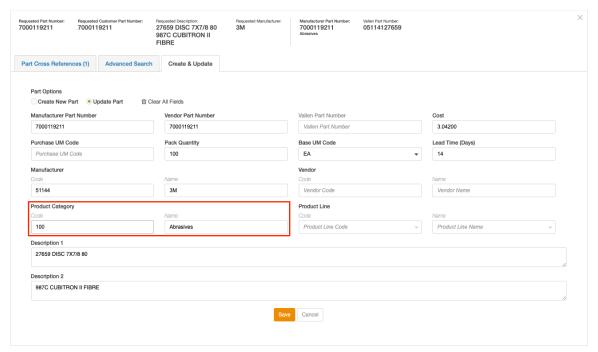


Updated Quote Price values for breaks 1 and 2

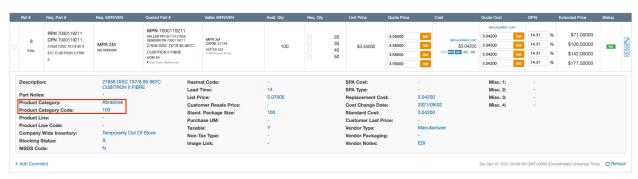
Note that the values in the Cost and Unit Price columns did not change.

1.2.1.4 product_category

The product_category field is an optional field for both APIs. When available, the system will look up the category a line item belongs to within the product_category table in Vallen's master data, and display the matching category in both Expand View and Create & Update.

1.2.2 New Fields in Response

1.2.2.1 is_nonstock

The new is_nonstock field is not included in the Get-Price-Availability and Get-Nonstock-Price API requests, but will be sent back to VallenIQ in the response we receive from both APIs whenever they are called by our application.

The purpose of this new field is to identify whether a part number is a stocking or non-stock item.

This information is required for two purposes:

- To determine how VallenIQ behaves when line item costs are changed
- To determine price and cost overrides for line items when they are added to an order

Stocking vs. Non-Stock Items

Parts are considered stocking items when:

- They have a valid Vallen part number
- And they have a stocking status of "S" (stocking)

Parts are considered non-stock when:

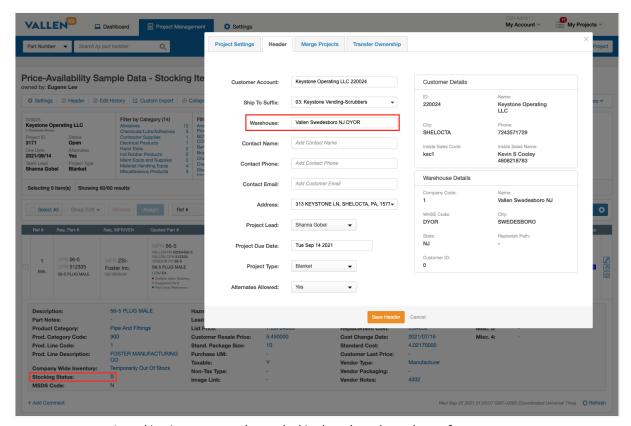
- They have a valid Vallen part number and a stocking status of "C" (catalog)
- Or the item does not have a valid Vallen part number (true non-stock)

However, there are scenarios in which a part can be a stocking item, but is not stocked in the chosen warehouse in the quote header.

In these scenarios, the item will be considered non-stock, and the Get-Nonstock-Price API, instead of the Get-Price-Availability API will be used to populate pricing for the line item.

In order to conclusively identify whether a line item should be considered stocking or non-stock, when lines are refreshed and either APIs are called, a new is_nonstock field will be included in both API responses, that will let VallenIQ know whether the item is truly stocking or non-stock.

Once received, the is_nonstock value will be stored by Supplyframe and will be utilized for the two purposes stated in the section above.



A stocking item may not be stocked in the selected warehouse for your quote

Cost Update Scenarios

When line item costs are changed in VallenIQ, corresponding prices will also update for only non-stock items, and prices will not change for stocking items.

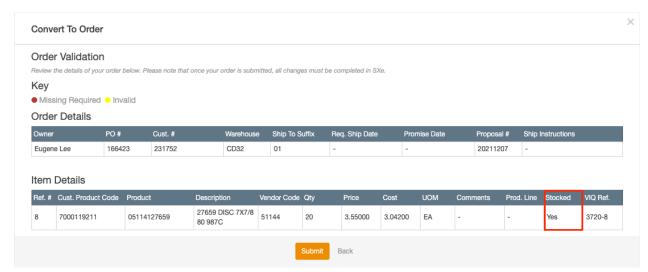
To determine if VallenIQ should ping the Get-Nonstock-Price API, the application will reference the value of the is_nonstock field.

Price & Cost Overrides During Order Creation

When line items are selected for Convert to Order, VallenIQ will use the stored is_nonstock value for each selected line item, and include this value in the Quote-to-Order API request.

When Converting to Order, the is_nonstock value will provide SX.e direction on whether to apply price and cost overrides for the order.

Note that the stocking status of line items will also be listed in the Convert to Order workflow for ease of reference:

2. Convert to Order Updates

A number of changes were made to the Quote-to-Order API used by the Convert to Order feature, which was originally released in v1.18. These updates will mainly affect the CSR team and not the Q&S team.

2.1 Request Parameters

In this release, two additional request parameters were added for the Quote-to-Order API:

- price
- is_nonstock

A full summary of the data fields the Quote-to-Order API will use when converting lines to orders are listed in the table below:

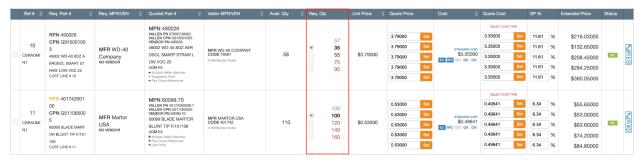
2.2 Select Line Item Quantity Break When Converting to Order

In the v1.18 release, when lines were selected to add to an order, the system would by default select the first Requested Quantity break (and associated price and cost break).

Vallen CSR users can now select which Requested Quantity break, as well as the price and cost associated with the break, to use when converting lines to orders.

2.2.1 Individual Lines

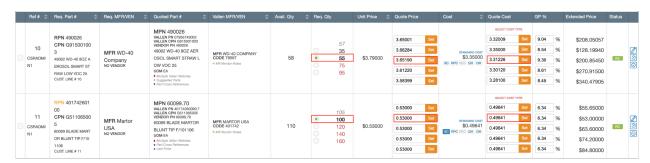
To select which quantity break you'd like to use for individual line items when creating new orders, select the appropriate Requested Quantity break for each line item:



Selection options available in Reg. Qty column

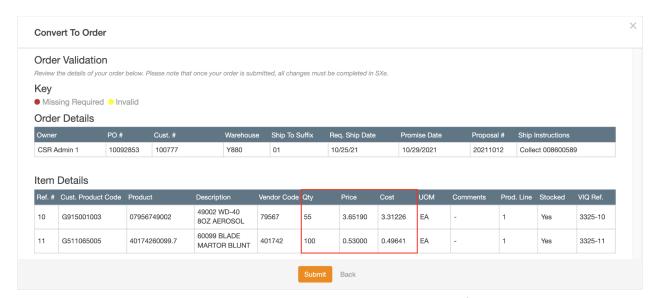
When a specific quantity break is selected, VallenIQ will also utilize the price and cost associated with the break when converting the lines to order.

Using the example below, if the highlighted Req. Qty's are added to an order:

The associated Quote Price and Quote Cost values will also be carried over into the Convert to Order workflow:



Qty, Price, and Cost values should align with selected quantity break from Project View

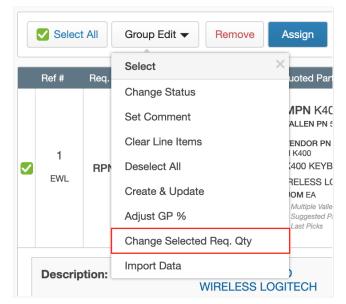
Note that the Usage quantity as well as the related price and cost cannot be selected and cannot be added to an order. Only Req. Qty breaks 1-4 and their price / cost values can be selected for an order.



Quantities, Quote Price, and Quote Cost Related to Usage cannot be selected for an order

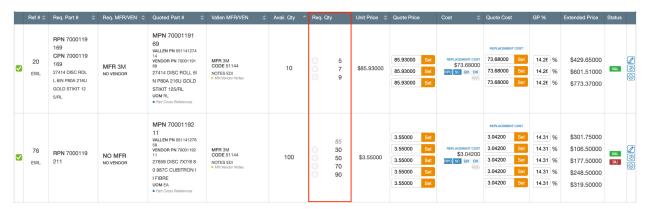
2.2.2 Group Edit

When creating new orders, to select which quantity break you'd like to use for multiple line items at once, select all line items that apply, navigate to the Group Edit dropdown, and click on the new "Change Selected Req. Quantity" button:



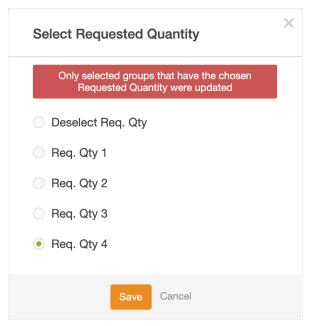
Use this option to choose which Req. Qty to select for multiple lines at once

You may encounter scenarios where some of the selected line items do not have the same Req. Qty breaks. For example, in this screenshot Ref # 20 only has Req. Qty's 1-3, but Ref # 76 has Req. Qty's 1-4:



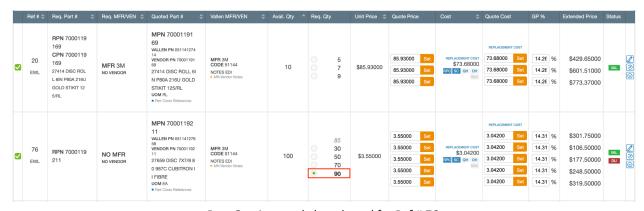
Req. Qty mismatches for selected line items

If both lines are selected and Req. Qty 4 is chosen in the "Select Requested Quantity" modal, the following error message will appear:



System message for "Select Requested Quantity" modal

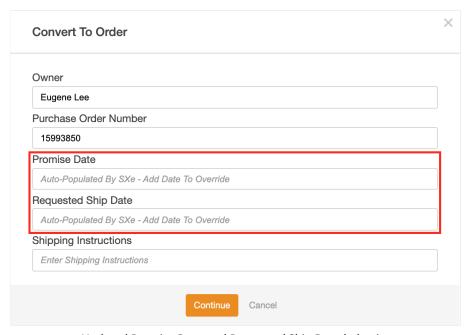
After exiting and returning back to the quote, you will notice that VallenIQ has only selected the specified Req. Qty break for the line item(s) that have that Req. Qty.

2.3 Requested Ship & Promise Date

In the Convert to Order workflow, the Promise Date and the Requested Ship Date are not required fields, and will be automatically populated by SXe if left empty.



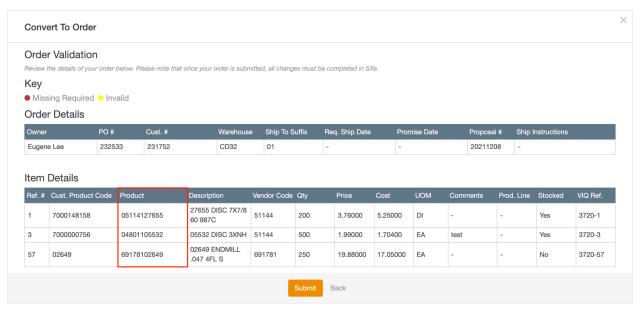
Updated Promise Date and Requested Ship Date behavior

However, users can choose to add dates if appropriate. When adding dates for these two fields, the Requested Ship Date cannot be greater than the Promise Date.

If users attempt to add a Requested Ship Date that is later than the chosen Promise Date, VallenIQ will now change the Promise Date to be the same as the Requested Ship Date.

2.4 Cascading Logic for Product Field

This cascading logic relates to the Product field in the Convert to Order workflow that will be sent in the Quote-to-Order API request:

There can be a number of part numbers that can be associated with a line item:

- Vallen Part Number (Vallen PN)
- Customer Part Number (CPN)
- Vendor Part Number (Vendor PN)
- Manufacturer Part Number (MPN)



Part number types for line items

When populating the product field that will be submitted to the Quote-to-Order API, VallenIQ will determine which part number to use based on the following logic:

- Use Vallen PN if it exists for line item
- If Vallen PN does not exist, use CPN
- If CPN does not exist, use Vendor PN
- If VPN does not exist, use MPN

3. Adjusted Conversion Factor Cost

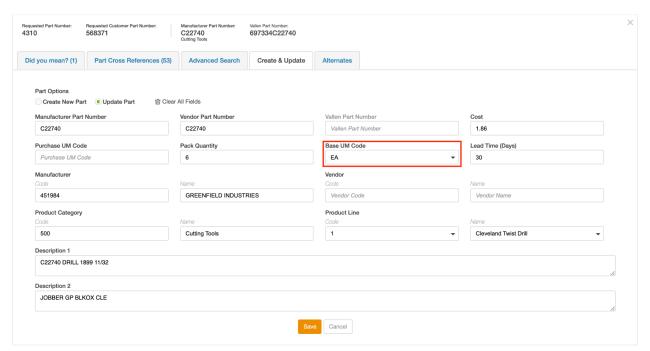
When the Price & Warehouse Inventory setting is selected for your quote and Base UM Code is changed for a stocking item, cost, price, and available quantity may update to coincide with the new unit of measure.

There are restrictions however that affect whether or not cost, price, and available quantity will change when Base UM Code is updated:

- These fields will never change when the Create New Part or Group Edit Create New Part features are used and should only change when Update Part is used
- These fields will only change when Base UM Code is updated for stocking items, not non-stock items
- These fields will only change when the new selected Base UM Code has a different conversion factor associated with it. If the new Base UM Code has the same conversion factor as the original, the cost, price, and available quantity should not change
- If the Price & Warehouse Inventory setting is not selected for the quote, only the cost can update; the unit price and available quantity should not change because VallenIQ will not ping the Get-Price-Availability API

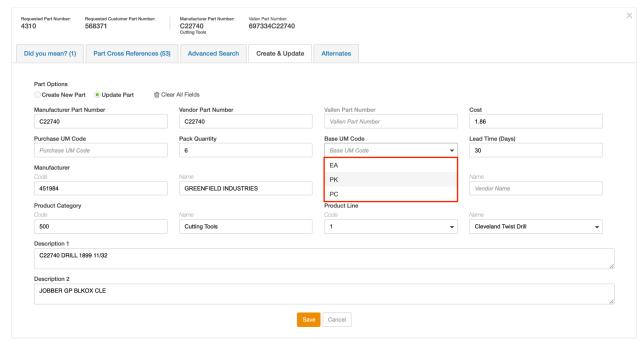
3.1 Changing Base UM Code

Change the Base UM Code in the Create & Update modal by selecting the highlighted field in the screenshot below.

When the field is selected, all valid Base UM Codes will appear in a dropdown below. Note that the application will use the Vallen part number for this line item to look up valid Base UM Codes in the product_uom table in Vallen's master data.

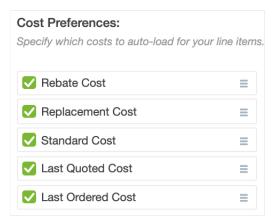


Valid Base UM Codes for current Vallen part number

3.2 Populating Cost Field in Create & Update Modal

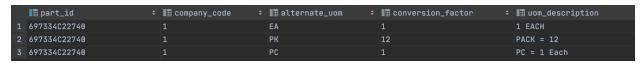
Only when the new selected Base UM Code has a conversion factor that is different than the original, VallenIQ will multiply the conversion factor (not visible in the application) with the first cost that is available for the Vallen part according to the specified Cost Preferences (in Project Settings) for the quote.



Cost Preferences for quote

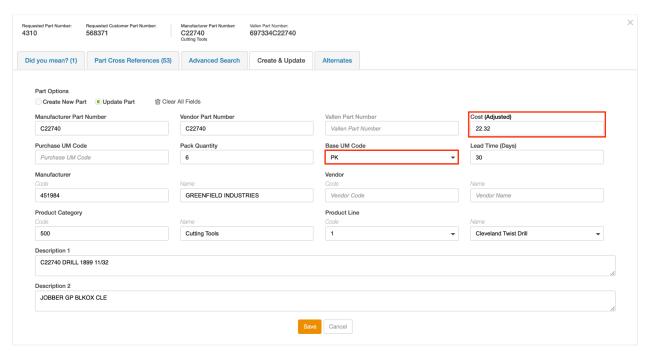
In this case, Vallen part number "697334C22740" does not have a Rebate Cost, but does have a Replacement Cost of 1.86.

VallenIQ will then use this value to multiply against the conversion factor for the new Base UM Code "PK", which is 12, to arrive at the new adjusted cost of 22.32.

When this happens, the application will show "(Adjusted)" to the right of the field name.

If the conversion factor of the new Base UM Code is the same as the old value ("PC" for example), the value in the Cost field will not change, and "(Adjusted)" will not appear in the field name.

Note that if the Cost field was changed by the user without updating the Base UM Code, "(Adjusted)" will not appear to the right of the Cost field.

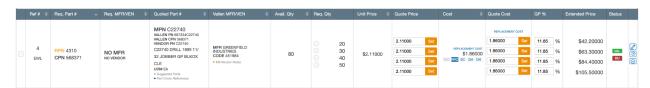
3.3 Project View Updates

If the new Adjusted Conversion Factor Cost is saved:

- In the Cost column, the system will:
 - Display the new adjusted cost
 - Display "Adjusted Cost" text above the column value
 - Display a new "AC" flag
- In the Quote Cost column, the system will:
 - Display the new Adjusted Cost in all cost breaks

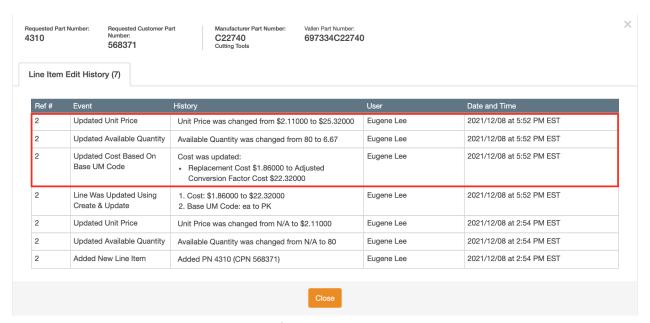
Additionally, if the Price & Warehouse Inventory setting is selected, VallenIQ will use the Adjusted Cost value in the Cost column to call the Get-Price-Availability API (Get-Nonstock-Price API will never be called because this feature only works for stocking items).

The Get-Price-Availability API will then return a new Unit Price. This value will update the Unit Price column, as well as all breaks in the Quote Price column.

The Get-Price-Availability API will also return a new Avail. Qty as well, which will be reflected in the line item.

3.4 Edit History

If the Base UM Code is changed to one that has a different conversion factor than the original, Edit History events will describe the changes that were made to your line item.

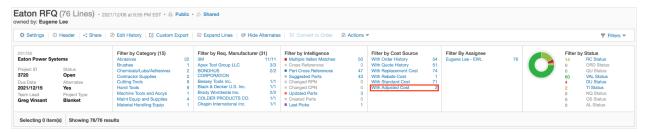


Edit History events for Adjusted Conversion Factor Cost

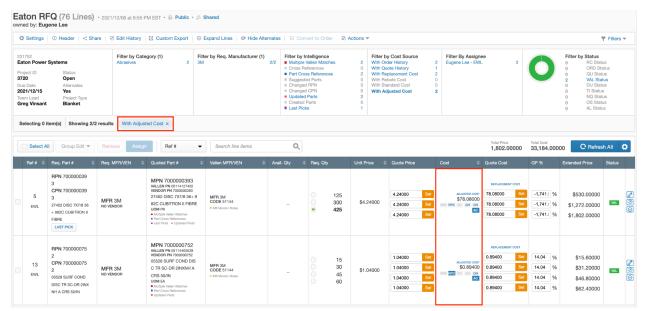
Note that these history events will not appear if a Base UM Code with the same conversion factor as the last Base UM Code is selected.

3.5 New Filter for Adjusted Cost

Within your projects, you can now filter line items by those that have an adjusted cost.



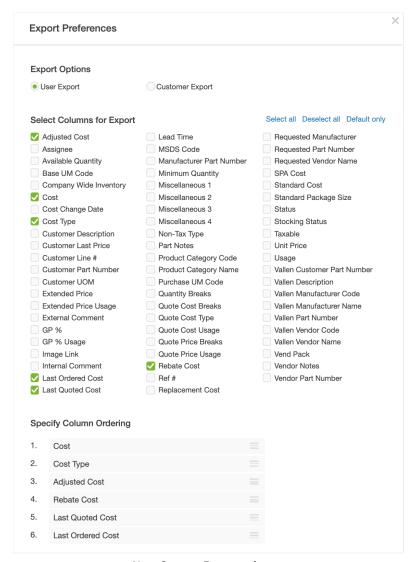
Adjusted Cost filter appears in Filter by Cost Source

3.6 New Custom Export Fields

A number of new fields, including Adjusted Cost, have been added to Custom Export:



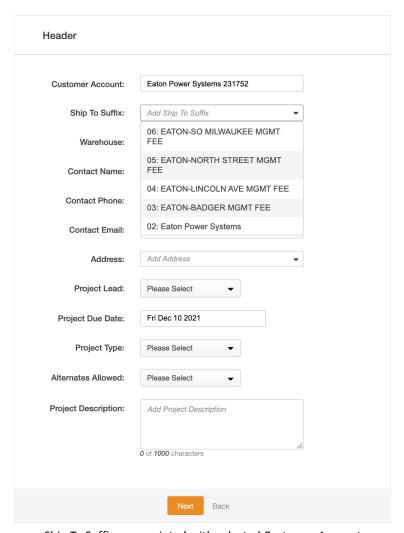
New Custom Export columns

- Cost: Exports value in Cost column
- Cost Type: Exports name of selected cost type in Cost column
- Adjusted Cost: Exports adjusted costs for line items if available, export column is blank if not
- Rebate Cost: Exports rebate costs for line items if available, export column is blank if not
- Last Quoted Cost: Exports the Last Quoted Cost for line items in your list if available, export column is blank if not
- Last Ordered Cost: Exports the Last Ordered Cost for line items in your list if available, export column is blank if not

4. Populate Default Warehouse Based on Ship To Suffix in Header

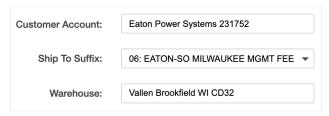
In the quote header, VallenIQ will use the chosen Customer Account and Ship To Suffix in the quote header to automatically populate the default warehouse for the quote.

For example, for customer "Eaton Power Systems 231752," there are a number of Ship To Suffix options for this account:

After choosing a Ship To Suffix, VallenIQ will automatically look up the default warehouse related to the Customer Account + Ship To Suffix combination and add this to the Warehouse field.



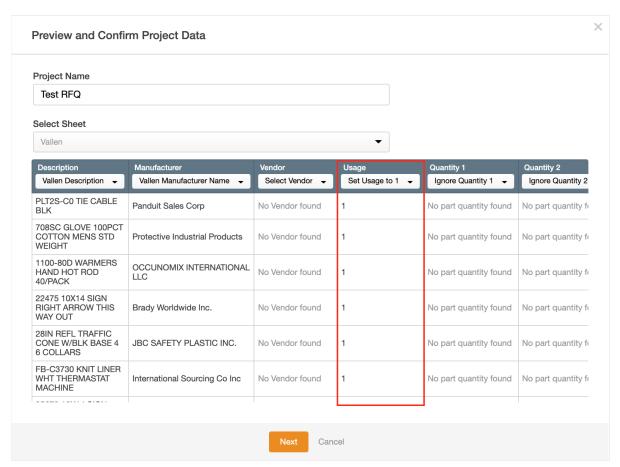
Default warehouse is auto-populated

Although VallenIQ now automatically populates default warehouses, users are still able to look up and choose a different warehouse for the quote header.

5. "Set Usage to 1" Option in Preview and Confirm

This enhancement will mainly apply to the Q&S team, because the CSR team does not use the Usage column.

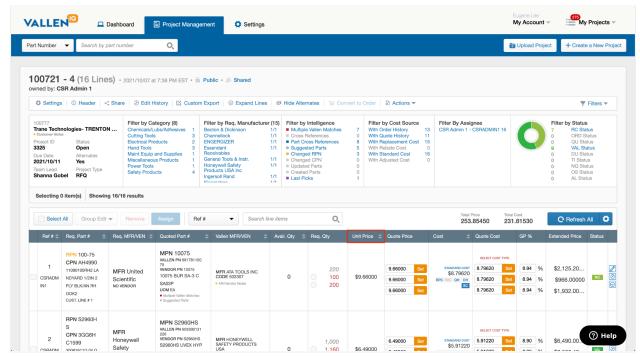
When using the Upload Project feature, users now have a new option to "Set Usage to 1." This option will always be available for this column, regardless of the RFQ file that is selected.

6. Rename "Price" Column to "Unit Price"

The "Price" column in the main quote page has been renamed to "Unit Price" to provide a more accurate description of the values that will appear here:



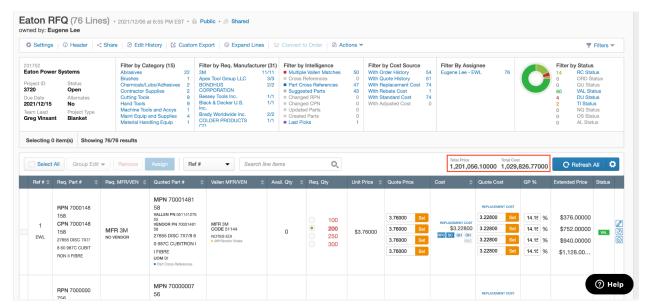
Unit Price column

7. Quote Totals Improvements

We've updated the quote totals that appear within your quotes and within the Dashboard tab in the Recent Projects section to now show a summary of both price as well as cost.

7.1 Within Quotes

Total Price and Total Cost will appear under the Filter Toolbar, to the left of the Refresh All button.

Only line items where a Req. Qty is selected will count towards Total Price and Total Cost calculations.

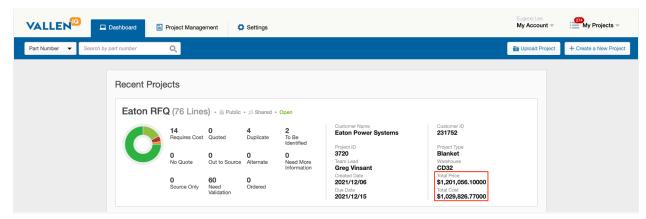
These totals are calculated as follows:

- <u>Total Price</u>: Sum of Extended Prices that correspond to selected Req. Qty breaks across all line items
 - For Ref #1 in the screenshot above, because Req. Qty 2 (200) is selected, VallenIQ will use Extended Price for qty 2 (\$752.00000) for the Total Price calculation
 - The app will add up the Extended Prices for all lines where a Req. Qty break is selected in the quote to populate the value for "Total Price"
- <u>Total Cost</u>: Sum of Extended Costs (quote cost * qty) that correspond to the selected Req. Qty breaks across all line items
 - In Ref #1, because Req. Qty 2 (200) is selected, VallenIQ will use Extended Cost \$645.60000 (\$3.22800*200) for the Total Price calculation

 The app will add up the Extended Costs for all lines where a Req. Qty break is selected in the quote to populate the value for "Total Cost"

7.2 Recent Projects

The Total Price and Total Cost figures in Recent Projects will be calculated the same as the totals within your quotes.

8. Show Suggestions Even With API Errors

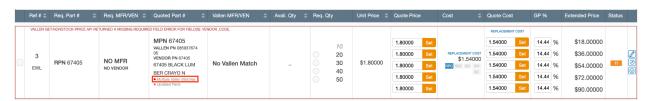
This enhancement will only apply to CSR quotes where the Price & Warehouse Inventory setting is selected.

Previously, when API errors would occur, VallenIQ would not display suggestions for these line items:

The application will now show available suggestions even when errors occur from either the Get-Price-Availability or Get-Nonstock-Price API:

9. Assign TI Status to Lines With API Errors

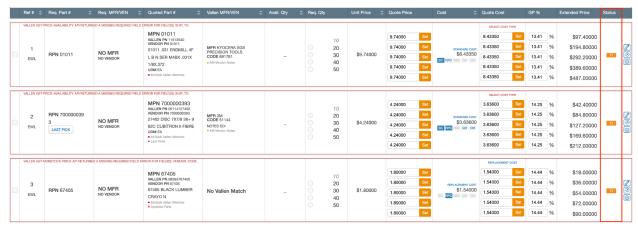
This enhancement will only apply to CSR quotes where the Price & Warehouse Inventory setting is selected.

Previously, when API errors would occur, VallenIQ would not assign statuses to these line items:



VallenIQ would not assign statuses to line items that experience API errors

In order to be consistent with status assignment behavior for line items that do not auto-match to part numbers when the Price & Warehouse Inventory setting is not selected, the application will now assign the TI status to lines that experience API errors.

10. Gross Profit % Calculation

This enhancement will primarily apply to CSR quotes where the Price & Warehouse Inventory setting is selected.

The calculation of Gross Profit % (GP%) has been updated to the following:

- Quote Price Quote Cost = Gross Profit
- (Gross Profit / Quote Price) * 100 = Gross Profit %

The columns that are used to calculate GP% are the following:



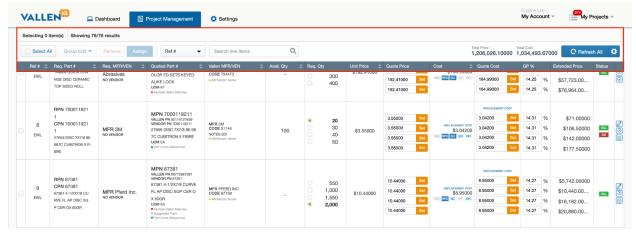
Values in Quote Price and Quote Cost are used to calculate GP%

Two points to note regarding GP% calculations are:

- GP% will always be below 100%
- 0% GP% is valid eg. when Quote Price and Quote Cost are the same

11. Frozen Top Bar While Scrolling

When scrolling through quotes, the following section will be frozen:



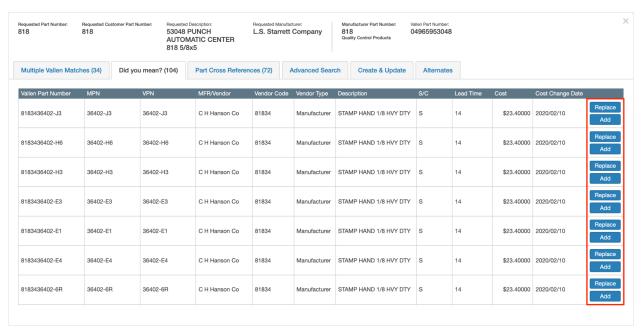
Highlighted section will be frozen as users navigate the lower sections of their quotes

This will allow users to see how many line items and filters are selected as they quote their line items, instead of requiring them to scroll to the top of the page to see these details.

12. Part Selection & Add As Alternate Updates

We've updated the user interface for loading new parts into line items and how parts are added as alternates in the following tabs in Quoted Part Number modal:

- Multiple Vallen Matches
- Did you mean?
- Part Xref
- Advanced Search
- Last Pick



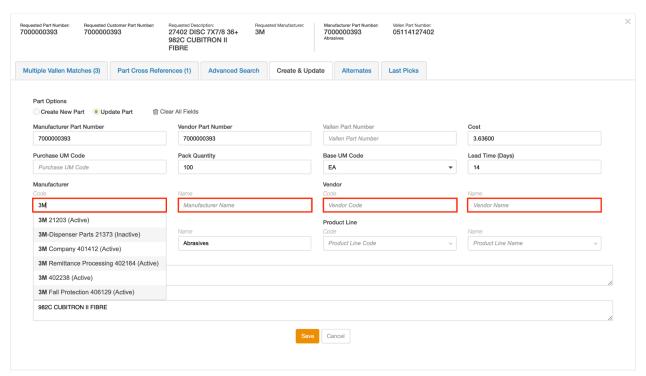
New "Replace" and "Add" buttons for suggestions tabs in Quoted Part Number modal

Selecting "Replace" will replace the current part in Quoted Part # column with the selected record.

Selecting "Add" will add the record as an Alternate to the current line item. Note that the "Add" button will only appear when the Alternates Allowed setting is set to "Yes."

13. Manufacturer & Vendor Status Wording Update

In the Create & Update tab, we show dropdowns that display Manufacturers and Vendors from Vallen's master data in the following areas:



Manufacturer Code / Name & Vendor Code / Name fields in Create & Update

Within the dropdowns, we also show the status of these manufacturers and vendors.

The statuses used to display as "Active" and "Deleted," but the deleted statuses have been renamed to "Inactive" to align better with SXe terminology.
