

# 1. "Set Quantity To 1" Option For Quantities 1-4


When uploading new projects into VallenIQ, you now have the option to populate the Quantity 1-4 columns to a value to 1 in the Preview and Confirm Project Data modal.

This feature is similar to the "Set Usage to 1" option that is available in the Usage column.



Note that when setting your quantities to one, it's best to do so sequentially (set Quantity 1 to value of 1, then Quantity 2 to value of 1 and so on).

When your project is uploaded, it will now show values of 1 for whichever quantity columns you selected this new option for:



#### 2. Custom Export Improvements

We've made two improvements to Custom Export:


- 1. Users can now export only selected values for Requested Quantity, Quote Price, Quote Cost, GP% and Extended Prices columns (these are available as five new export options)
- 2. The previously available export options for the values mentioned in 1 have been renamed to be consistent with functionality

#### 2.1 Export Selected Values


Previously, when Custom Exporting Requested Quantities, Quote Prices, Quote Costs, GP Percentages, and Extended Prices, VallenIQ would export all breaks for these fields.

In this release, you will now be able to export only the values that are selected to your downloaded file.

For example, for a project that contains the following line items:



You now have the option to select the following new Custom Export options:



And in your exported file, you will now only see the values associated with the Requested Quantity you've selected:

#### 2.2 Custom Export Field Name Changes

Now that we've introduced the five new Custom Export fields discussed above, we've renamed the previously available export options to be more descriptive.


The following Custom Export option names have been changed:


- Extended Price → All Extended Prices
- GP % → All GP Percentages
- GP % Usage → GP Percentage Usage
- Quantity Breaks → All Requested Quantities
- Quote Cost Breaks → All Quote Costs
- Quote Price Breaks → All Quote Prices

# 3. Show Transaction Details From SX.e In Edit History After Submission


When a transaction is successfully submitted to SX.e, VallenIQ will now show the transaction type, the transaction #, and any SX.e acknowledgement messages that are returned from SX.e in Project Level Edit History to help users keep track of transactions they've submitted.

For example, if the following two line items are selected and are added to a new transaction:






If these are the confirmation details for your successful transaction submission:



The details above will appear in the Project Level Edit History event that was created for this transaction:



Note that these details will not appear in Line Item Edit History for the items submitted in your transaction. SX.e order details will only appear in the Project Level Edit History.

### 4. Quick Search

The Advanced Search feature has been added to the top navigation bar and can be accessed from any page of the app.


You can use this feature to search for customer requested items more efficiently, check availability, and add search results to existing or new projects.

This enhancement is particularly helpful for single line item customer requests, where users will no longer have to immediately create a new project or open an existing project to use Advanced Search in order to search for requested items from customers.


Ultimately, this option may help save a number of steps in the quoting workflow.

#### 4.1 New Advanced Search Button & Modal

Advanced Search is now available on the top right of VallenIQ's navigation bar:



When selected, the Advanced Search modal will appear:




The same options and search requirements available in the Advanced Search tab in Quoted Part # modal within your projects applies to this modal.


"Part Master" searches will search for items in Vallen's master part table and the "Modified Parts" option will run your search against previously updated parts.

Users have the ability to search using one or more categories (Part Number, Description, and MFR/Vendor) but keep in mind that the minimum number of characters you need to conduct a search is three characters per field.

In the search results, it's important to note that results will be limited to 500, just like Advanced Search in the Quoted Part # modal:




Within the results table above, we've added another column titled "QOH." This column stands for Quantity On Hand, and is the same field we show in Line Item Expand view:




#### 4.2 Adding A Result To Project

Once you've found the item you're looking for, select the "Add to Project" button in the results table:




A pop up will appear that shows you the 20 most recently created projects within your account, and also an option to "Create New Project."


If an existing project is selected in "My Projects," VallenIQ will add the selected search result to the bottom of the project with a Usage value of 1 and a Requested Quantity value of 1, and will take you to the project page:



Alternatively, if the "Create New Project" option is selected, VallenIQ will open the new project header modal and prompt you to walk through the same steps as if you've selected the "Create a New Project" button in the top right navigation bar of the application:




Once the project header and preference details are populated, VallenIQ will take you to the new list you've created, with the selected search result loaded into Project View:




The same quantities (Usage value of 1 and Requested Quantity 1 value of 1) mentioned above will appear in the line item.

# 5. Frozen Header Improvements

As you scroll through your projects, the entire Filter Toolbar section will now be frozen by default:



To hide the Filter Toolbar, select the "Filter" button on the top right of the page, and select "Hide Filters:"



# 6. Notable Bug Fixes

- Shipping Instructions now match Ship To Suffixes in the Project Header, and match to those in SX.e
- When using the Convert to SX.e feature, SX.e will populate default dates consistently when Requested Ship and Promise Dates are not provided
- All formatting has been removed from fields that had currency and percentage formatting (price, cost, GP%, etc.) exported using Custom Export feature
