



1. Results Per Page & Pagination For Teams & Projects Reports

We've made the following three enhancements to the Teams & Projects reports page in the Settings tab:

- Results Per Page
- Go-To-Page and Pagination
- Default sorting for all reports



These enhancements apply to all reports for both the ISR and Q&S teams available on this page.

1.1 Results Per Page

Similar to the Results Per Page feature within projects, users can now choose how many results they'd like to see in their report.

The default selected option will be 125 results per page, but the number of results can also be set to 250 or 500.

1.2 Go-To-Page & Pagination

On the bottom right of each report, users now have access to a go-to-page feature with left and right arrows to navigate to different pages in their reports.

To use the go-to-page feature, either type in the page you want to go to into the highlighted text entry box below, or click the up and down arrows to find the page you want to view, then press the enter button on your keyboard:



1.3 Default Sorting For All Reports

All reports will now be sorted by the "Project" column in descending order. This means the most recently created projects in VallenIQ will show at the top of each report.


2. Retain Lines In Filter

Previously, when a user selected a filter and edited a line item such that it no longer qualifies for the filter, the line item would drop from view.

This could be disruptive to the quoting process, especially for larger projects, because the user would no longer have visibility into the dropped line.


If the line had to be edited further, the user would have to search for the line item again within the project, then edit the line as necessary.

Now, when a filter is applied:



Users can edit line items so they no longer belong in the filter they've selected. VallenIQ will then highlight the lines and display text that says "Does not qualify for filters."


This notifies users that the lines now do not meet filter criteria, but VallenIQ will continue to keep the lines on the page so they can be edited further if needed:



The line items will remain visible until the page is refreshed or until the filters are changed again (filters are added, removed, or all filters are cleared).

3. Alphabetize Matched Manufacturers In More Filters

We've alphabetized results in the "Matched Manufacturers" tab in the "More Filters" modal.



4. Expand Custom Export Modal Horizontally

We've expanded the Custom Export modal horizontally so users can see more of the modal in one page, and to make it easier to view and use this feature.
