
1. Show Pricing In Advanced Search

VallenIQ (VIQ) now shows pricing when parts are looked up in Advanced Search, which may help save steps in the quoting process.

Users no longer need to add part numbers into existing projects or create new projects to find pricing information. Instead, they can look up availability, price, and cost information in a single location.


1.1 Advanced Search In Navigation Bar

To see pricing in Advanced Search, select the new "Include Price" checkbox:



In order to receive pricing from SX.e, the application will ask you to populate the necessary header fields to retrieve pricing.


Fill in the four new fields in addition to the Part Number, Description, and/or the MFR/Vendor search criteria before you search.




It's important to note that these "Include Price" fields are not used to narrow down your search results. Instead, they are only used to request pricing from SX.e

This means that populating Base UM Code and Warehouse, for example, will not filter your search results by the Base UM Code or Warehouse selected.




Select the "Get Pricing" button to receive pricing, then after reviewing your search results, select the "Add to Project" button to add a result to an existing or a new project in VIQ.





Note that if you received pricing for a search result, and you add the search result to an existing project, the Unit Price you see for this line item may differ from the Unit Price you received in Advanced Search.

This can happen when the header information in Advanced Search:





Is different than the header information in the project you've selected:



1.2 Advanced Search In Quoted Part # Modal

Pricing can also be shown for Advanced Search results in the Quoted Part # modal.

The same details discussed in section 1.1 applies to this location, except for the following:

- Results can't be added to other projects
- Users can instead replace the current part number with a search result
- Or a search result can be added to the current line item as an alternate (assuming the project setting 'Alternates Allowed' is set to 'Yes')

2. Paste Sort IDs Into Ref # Search

Oftentimes, customers will add a "Sort ID" (or similarly named) column in their RFQ files that number the line items in the list.

Users are now able to copy and paste the numbers in these columns from customer RFQs into the Ref # Search bar in Project View, to make the process of finding these lines in VIQ easier:



When the range of numbers highlighted above is pasted into the field below and searched, VIQ will filter your list by matching reference numbers:
